What Planned Parenthood says:

“There’s no such thing as a “normal” age for becoming sexually active.

Deciding whether to have sex is a highly personal decision that can be influenced by a variety of factors, such as religion, family and personal values, peer influence, and the status of your relationship. Planned Parenthood Abortion Center Accused of Hiding 11 Year-Old’s Rape

In the “Shared Stories” section of Planned Parenthood Golden Gate’s website, a client’s shared her story. “I was raped at 11, by my 17 year old boyfriend. ... Planned Parenthood [sic] helped me deal with the aftermath of the rape allowing me to deal and cope as best as I could in my own way.” (LIFENEWS.COM | 12/15/05)

Connecticut Planned Parenthood Did Abortion in Sexual Abuse Coverup

Police investigating a kidnapping and sexual abuse case in Connecticut have confirmed that a Planned Parenthood abortion business did an abortion on a 15 year-old girl who is the victim [of a 41 year old man]. ...Planned Parenthood did not appear to report the 15 year-old pregnancy or her desire for an abortion to officials to look into the possibility she was sexually abused. Planned Parenthood in Sex Abuse Coverup Cited for Falsifying Abortion Reports

[T]he Indiana State Department of Health found almost three hundred improperly filed reports in a one year period of time for just one of Planned Parenthood’s clinics. ... [T]he omission of the age of the woman at the time of the abortion makes it appear there could be instances where Planned Parenthood is doing abortions on girls who are victims of statutory rape.
