Planned Parenthood Used Underage Girls in Clinical Trials

Twenty-eight Planned Parenthood affiliates have been involved in 33 clinical trials, some of which received government funds, and 10 of them involved girls as young as 13 years of age. That number represents one-third of all clinical trials surveyed in the STOPP report. (*LifeNews.com* October 6, 2009)

The International Agency for Research on Cancer lists the following as a **Group 1 Carcinogen** (cancer causing agent for humans):

- Estrogen-progestogen **oral contraceptives** (combined)

Note: The longer the duration of usage (greater than 5 years), the greater the cancer risk (especially breast and cervical) and requires 10 years for the effects to wear off.

Teenage girls will be on the Pill for many years, exposed to cancer risk that would show up later in life, without their parents' knowledge - Planned Parenthood's valuable service to the community.
